II. Cluster mission and objectives:

Cluster was founded as a part of the project No. CBC01013 Forests for Society - Forests Without Barriers, implemented through Norwegian Grants within the Cross-Border Cooperation Program. Cluster was founded by four project partners from Slovakia and two partners from Ukraine, who are members of the Cluster Board, as well.

Cluster is an association of equivalent members based on the mutual trust and cooperation.

The main objective of the cluster is to improve the development of cross-border cooperation within the Slovak-Ukrainian region and the promotion of sustainable development, tourism and the interpretation of natural values through intensive information exchange and counseling. Cluster enables to improve the potential of individual members and to promote common procedures in the development of the Slovak-Ukrainian region. It establishes a network of cooperating entities operating in concerned areas in order to create mutual cooperation among members of the cluster, supports and develops the cross-border cooperation of the Slovak-Ukrainian region among the members of the cluster, ensures information exchange, increases the potential of individual members in the field of development of regions and tourism through cluster membership. Membership in the cluster is free of charge.

IV. Cluster activity during the period of January – April 2017

The Cluster activity was associated with the activities of the international project FORSOC www.forsoc.org in which cluster was established in 2016 in Košice as a network of Slovakia-

Ukrainian inter-related institutions created by the project partners to promote the border region, exchange of information and counseling. At the General Assembly of the Cluster, which took place on 28 April 2017, new members of the cluster - organizations from different economic areas from Slovakia and Ukraine were introduced. The discussion was about the possibility of joining to the new project within Call for project proposals from the Norwegian Financial Mechanism. In the cluster there were 19 members at the end of this period (12 entities from Slovakia and 6 Ukrainian entities).

V. Cluster activity during the period of May – December 2017

From May 2017, the cluster activity followed the previous period and the cooperation of individual members has begun. The cluster website www.forsoc.org has been presented with opportunities for cooperation through project participation in the Program of cross-border cooperation. Within the partnership, 2 projects were submitted through the HU-SK-RO-UA Cross-border Cooperation Program 2014-2020:

- The project "Roads to healthy forests", submitted by the State Enterprise "Uzhhorod Forest Enterprise" (lead applicant, member of the cluster, UA), other partners are: FORZA (UA) member of the cluster, Municipal Forests of Spišská Belá, Ltd., (SK) member of the cluster, Municipal Forests of Kežmarok, Ltd., (SK), State Forests Tatra National Park, (SK) and State Enterprise "Vygoda Forest Management" (UA). The aim of the project is to improve accessibility to forest areas in the region of Prešov Slovakia and Zakarpattya and Ivano-Frankivsk regions in Ukraine, to restore climate-affected forests and to increase the level of forest workers education of nature protection in these regions.
- The project "Forest in Motion: Knowledge and Keeping for Common Natural Values in the UA-SK Cross-border Area" focused on the development of the Transcarpathian and Frankivsk region in Ukraine and Prešov region in Slovakia. The main objective of the project is to recognize and promote the natural values and potentials of the protected areas of the Ukrainian-Slovak cross-border region. There will be cooperation between Cluster members from Ukraine FORZA Agency as lead partner and National Park "Zacharovanyi kraj" together with partners from Slovakia State forestry agricultural enterprise Ulíč and State Forests Tatra National Park.

Another cluster activity was aimed at promoting tourism and raising awareness of forestry and nature protection through forest pedagogy activities. In May 2017, the pilot activity of program. "To the Forest with Forester" has begun and took place for 90 primary school pupils from Spišská Belá town and its surroundings, in cooperation with members of the cluster - National Forest Centre and Municipal Forests of Spišská Belá, Ltd. On the occasion of the establishment the company Municipal Forests of Dobšiná in October 2017 there was a public ceremonial program, were took place National Forest Centre and Secondary forestry school from Prešov - cluster members, which have prepared activities of forest pedagogy.

FORZA Agency during this period of time, was also actively promoting ideas of forest pedagogics, particularly representative of FORZA held forest pedagogics during three events organized for school children (Myro Lito Festival in Uzhhorod in June, Forest Fest in Uzhhorod in September, Forest Rangers Meeting in Lumshory in August), one event for children with disabilities (in Uzhhorod in December) as well as during two events for teachers and pedagogs (EdCamp festival in Uzhhorod in August and Ukrainian Forum of Climatic Education in Kyiv in November). Besides this, FORZA was an active co-organizer of Forest Fest in Zakarpattya, promoting approaches of forest pedagogics and interactive learning among forestry enterprises.

The National Park "Zacharovanyi kraj" during this period has carried out several activities related to the promotion of the region and the development of tourism in the given area as follows:

Cluster Action plan for 2018

- 1. Cooperation during the event "Forestry day" in the area of communication and public relations in Košice. Goal is to raise awareness of forestry and nature protection and promote tourism in the region.
- 2. Cooperation during the event Forest Fest in Zakarpattya, Ukraine, with other forest enterprises of the region, including cluster members.
- 3. Promotion of the forest pedagogics approach among foresters and pedagogues of other regions of Ukraine.
- 4. Cooperation among cluster members on preparation of project proposal within Norway mechanism International Cooperation Program.
- 5. Participation at the program of forest pedagogy "To the Forest with Forester" for primary school pupils from Spišská Belá town. Goal is to develop the region in the area of forest tourism.
- 6. Meetings of the cluster members and effective communication on the issues of tourism, forestry, public relations and looking for solutions, that will contribute for better development of the region.
